When Bella faces unexpected and threatening situations, she is willing to risk her human life and the possible immortality of vampires. Meyer finished a book profile in 2003, but developed it and changed as New Moon and Eclipse wrote, although the main and most significant stories remained unchanged. Little, Brown and Company have taken some steps to prevent book content from leaking, such as closing forums and message forums on different fanites and provide a special email address for fans to send links to online losses and spoilers. Breaking Dawn was released on August 2, 2008 at midnight release parties in over 4,000 libraries across the US. [8] Since its first printing of 3.7 million copies, more than 1.3 million have been sold in the United States and 20,000 inkingdom combined in the first 24 hours of book release, establishing a record in the first day sales performance for the hachette book group oa. [9] the book was very successful, selling over 6 million copies in 2008, and was the third best-selling novel in 2008 behind twilight and new moon. Unlike the previous three voices of the series, breaking dawn received mixed reviews from critics. is also the most controversial book in the series, as adult themes and concepts are explored more directly than in its predecessors. However, the novel was awarded the british book award as "Children's Year Book." was translated into 38 languages with rights sold in over 50 countries. the book was adapted into a two-part film, with the first part released on November 18, 2011, and the second part released on November 16, 2012. plot summary breaking dawn is divided into three separate parts. the first part details the wedding of beautiful and honeymoon with edward, which spend on isle esme, a private island off the coast of the brazil that carlisle owns. Two weeks in their honeymoon, beautiful realizes she's pregnant. because the fetus is part vampire, its condition progresses at an unnaturally accelerated rate. beautiful and edward return immediately home to forks, Washington, where the fetus continues to develop at an abnormal speed, causing beautiful physical and emotional discomfort. the second part of the book is written by the perspective of jacob black, a native American quileute, which, asmembers of his tribe, can change form in a wolf. Knowing Bella's desire to become a vampire, she is immediately suspicious when she returns from her honeymoon and the Cullens keep her father, Charlie, to see her. By believing that the Cullens have broken their treaty to avoid another human being, he advances on their home that he intends to kill Edward. She arrives and discovers that Bella is suffering a difficult pregnancy in which the fetus is draining her life. Jacob asks Bella to stop the fetus to save his life, like neither Carlisle, a doctor, nor Alice who can see the future, are optimistic on Bella's prognosis. Despite the concerns that her pregnancy will be fatal, Bella is determined to continue, believing that she can survive long enough to give birth and then be transformed into a vampire. While wolves are telepathic, they feel Jacob's thoughts on Bella. Fearing Bella will give birth to an uncontrollable child, thirsty for blood, want to kill her and fetus. Jacob accepts his bloodline as the real package leader to get rid of the alpha, Sam's control. Go warn the Cullen that the wolf pack wants to kill Bella. Travelling to the Cullens, Seth Clearwater, a younger member of the package, breaks and joins Jacob. He notes that once they have formed their own package, they can no longer hear the thoughts of other wolves. They patrol the property of Cullens and shortly after Leah, Seth's older sister and the lonely female wolf, join them. Beautiful enters work as the childfighting his way out, breaking his body. Edward is forced to perform a cesarean section, saving the child. While Bella is dying, Edward injects his poison into his heart. Jacob, believing Bella's dead, blames Bella Renesmee's daughter. He goes to kill the child, and instead "imprints" (an involuntary response in which a shapeshifter finds his soul mate) on her. The third section returns to Bella's perspective, describing her painful transformation, finally waking up to be turned into a vampire. Completely recovered, she likes her new life and her vampire skills. Renesmee grows rapidly in a child, and is located remotely from Irina, a vampire of the Alaskan congressa. Misidentifying as a " immortal son", a human child who has been transformed into an uncontrollable vampire, Irina presents her accusations to the Volturi who have banned the creation of such creatures. As the largest and most powerful vampire coven, the Volturi see Renesmee and Cullens as a threat and plot to destroy them. By providing their arrival, the Cullens gather other vampire clans from all over the world to witness and demonstrate to the Volturi that Renesmee is not an immortal child. Jacob's imprint on Renesmee has forged an indissoluble bond and a mutual protection pact between the Cullen and the Quileute, ending hatred among themselves. As local and foreign vampires arrive, the Cullen house becomes the headquarters and the training ground for assorted vampires and the Quileutepackages. Addressing the allies and witnesses gathered in Cullen, the Volturi discover that they have been misinformed about Renesmee's identity, and execute Irina in a failed attempt to instigate a complete battle. The Volturi raise the Cullens pact with the Quileuti Wolves and the uncertainty of Renesmee's future in an attempt to further provoke hostilities, defining it as a possible threat to the secret existence of vampires. Alice and Jasper, who had left before the Cullen Allies meeting, return with a Mapuche called Nahuel, a 150-year-old vampire-human hybrid like Renesmee. With him there is his biological aunt, Huilen, who explains that his sister fell in love with a vampire and was pregnant with her son, even though she died in childbirth. When Nahuel was born, he bit his aunt and made her immortal. Nahuel shows that hybrids are no threat, and Volturi accept to leave the Cullens alone. The Cullens and their allies return to peace in their homes, realizing that the Volturi can return one day. When Edward and Bella are alone, he allows him to read his mind for the first time, sharing his feelings about him. Background development Originally, Meyer wrote a book entitled Forever Dawn, which was a direct sequel to Twilight. [10] While the basic plot remained the same, Forever Dawn was narrated completely from Bella's point of view, the werewolves and Jacob were "developed only sketches", Victoria and Laurent were both alive, and there was ameyer continued to say that "can publish some extras a day, if ever I have time to go back through the manuscript forever dawn, it is only until breaking dawn." the part that required meyer the longest time to write of breaking dawn was the half-chapter that describes the 3 months after the transformation of beautiful in a vampire because "the amount of time per word put in that section was probably ten times what was in exciting new [12] Meyer decided to include pregnancy in his story as he was looking for vampires, early 2003, and came across the legend of the nightmare, a demon who could make children. [11] the insistence of not letting the son die was inspired by the reaction of meyer when he asked if he would let one of his children die so that he could live, that he had to deliver the child regardless of the consequences. [13] meyer said in an interview with shannon hale, published in the twilight saga: the official illustrated guides, that the Christmas scene published is a little less grotesque than he wrote before editing due to the demands of his publisher, agent and publisher to "renounce violence a little." he said that pregnancy and the birth of beautiful, for her, were "a way to explore that concept of what the child was" in the past and recognized that they were "take beautiful in a sack that was not a retable. [14]the subject of Bella's relatability, Meyer admitted that he lost part of his relatability to the character when he became a vampire and said: "All in all to that point in the story [the transformation] I would say that I could enter this story right here and I could do everything that could do that made it really fun. "[15] Meyer wanted to experience Bella's vampire experiences and "his hardest step wanted to write a lot" [15] Renesmee's unique name, Meyer wrote that "he could not have called her Jennifer or Ashley. What is the name of the most unique child in the world? I looked through a lot of websites named the child. At the end, I realized there was no human name that would work for me, so I surrendered to the need and I invented mine." [11] Meyer says to finish the series: The Twilight Saga is really the story of Bella, and this was the natural place for his history to finish. He crossed the main obstacles in his way and fought his way to the place he wanted to be. I guess I can try to prolong his story unnaturally, but it wouldn't be interesting enough to keep me written. Stories need conflicts, and conflicts that are Bella-centric are resolved. [11] Influence The Merchant of Venice and A Midsummer Night's Dream by William Shakespeare both influenced Breaking Dawn. [16] Meyerthat Alice wrote her beautiful instructions on a page of the Venetian merchant to give a clue that the final confrontation at the end of the book would be mental, not a physical battle, like the one at the end of the game. It also suggests that the novel would have a happy ending for couples, as in the merchant of venetian. Originally it was the novel by Jane eyre of charlotte brontë that Alice ripped a page from, but jane eyre had nothing to do with the story, so meyer changed it. [17] the idea of imprinting, which existed in forever dawn, was inspired by the dream of a mid-summer night. meyer described it as "the magic of setting things right - which does not happen in the real world, which is absolutely fantasy," and decided to introduce previously - in eclipse - so that it should not have explained later. [17] the art of the cover meyer described the cover as "extremely significant" and said that it was "very happy with how it turned off." [18] the cover is a metaphor for the progression of beautiful throughout the series; began as the physically weakest player on the edge, the pawn, but eventually becomes the strongest, the queen. [11] the chessboard also suggests the conclusion of the novel "where the battle with the voluntaris is one of the ingenuity and strategy, not physical violence. " [19] title the title, breaking dawn, is a reference at the beginning of the beautiful life as a newly born vampire. [11] wishing to add a "sense of disaster" to the title to match the mood of the novel, he called itDawn. Another reason to give the book this particular title is that it corresponds to the plot of the book, which focuses on "a new awakening and a new day and there are also a lot of problems inherent in it".[18] Release Marketing Weekly released a Breaking Dawn extract on May 30, 2008. [20] Stephenie Meyer also revealed a "Quote of the Day" by Breaking Dawn for about three weeks before his release on August 2, 2008. The first quote was published on Meyer's website on 12 July 2008. [21] The first chapter of Breaking Dawn, "Engaged", was published in the special edition of Eclipse.[22] Breaking Dawn was officially released on August 2, 2008 through midnight release parties in over 4,000 libraries,[8] most of which involved costume and trivia competitions, handicrafts and facial painting. [23] Godiva also made a Twilight theme chocolate bar, which was published in Barnes & Noble book shops at release parties. [24] A series of four-city Breaking Dawn concerts, with Stephenie Meyer and Justin Furstenfeld, of the Blue October, coincided with the release of the novel. The concert series sold three of its four venues on the day tickets were sold,[25] selling in less than an hour in a city. [26] Publication Before the novel was published, the first three Twilight books had already sold 8.5 million copies in the United States[9] and over 2 million copies in the UK. [27] Breaking Dawn was one of the most anticipated books of 2008 with The Guardian noting, "Teenagers throughThe world is eagerly awaiting the next installment of the vampire novel series Stephenie Meyer." [8] To satisfy the high demand, Little, Brown Books added a print of 500,000 additional copies just before the title was published, bringing the initial print to 3.7 million. [9] The book sold 1.3 million copies in the United States[9] and 20,000 copies in the UK in the first 24 hours of release.[28] and 100,000 copies in Canada during its first weekend. [29] Breaking Dawn debuted at #1 on the list of top 150 US Today sellers and continued to spend over 58 weeks on the list. [30] It was also the best-selling children's book of 2008 with over 6 million copies sold. [31] A special edition of Breaking Dawn was released on August 4, 2009, containing a DVD of the Breaking Dawn Concert Series and an interview with Meyer. [32] The critical reception of Breaking Dawn was mixed. Lev Grossman wrote: "Before, since there is a lot of reviews at a star on Amazon, let me say in front: I loved Breaking Dawn."[33] Dear von Wrangel Kinsey of School Library Journal responded with a positive review, describing the book as eye-catching and noting, "While this novel is darker and more mature than previous titles, Meyer's twists and shifts are not out of character." [34] Charlotte's observer accepted and called the book "pretty darned good", but criticized the length of the book saying: "I would like [Stephenie Meyer] not to feel compelled to pack so much in a single volume. It should have been two.Mary Harris Russell of the Chicago Tribune also responded with a positive review and greeted the book as a "fun bed", noting that Stephenie Meyer "continue to produce witty writing on families, adolescents and popular culture".[36] while the time called the book "a wild but satisfying problem at Bella and Edward's ballad" and gave him a rating of A-.[37] An article in The Daily News Tribune said of stilyer No one has to give up anything or suffer more than temporarily—in other words, greatness is out. " [39] In an article by The Associated Press, journalist Sara Rose wrote on NewsOK.com that fans of the series will love "the addictive characters, great humor, a distracted obsession with beauty, will focus on the minuzies of emotions"; However, "the random readers can be disappointed by a lot of compilation activity and little.[40] Independent called the book, "sable, serving, tactially, tactiely, evil-doing, to live "B"[41] Entertainment Weekly classified Breaking Dawn with a D, criticizing Bella's Christmas and "unexpected" scenefor Edward" and do not have any other goals. [42] The Washington Post also responded with a negative review, commenting as, "Meyer put a stake through the heart of his beloved creation," and "Breaking Dawn has a delivery sequence that can promote abstinence throughout life in sensitive types"[43] In an interview with Entertainment Weekly, Meyer responded to the negative response of many fans to the book and called it the "Rob Effect"; [44] Awards and honors Breaking Dawn was the recipient of a British Book Award for "Book of the Year of Children". [45] In 2009, "Premio del libro dei bambini", the novel was chosen as "Teen Choice Book of the Year" and Meyer won the "Author of the Year" award. [46] Film adaptations Main articles: The Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn – Part 1 and The Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn – Part 2 Summit Entertainment announced in November 2008 that they had obtained the rights to the fourth book of Stephenie Meyer, Breaking Dawn. [47] The greenlit studio is an adaptation of The Twilight Saga: Breaking Dawn in April 2010. The film was divided into two parts; the first part of the film was released on 18 November 2011.[48] and the second part was released on 16 November 2012. [49] Bill Condon directed both sides; Stephenie Meyer co-produced the film with Karenand Wyck Godfrey.[50] In July 2010, Summit announced that the film would be filmed in Vancouver, Canada and Baton Rouge, Louisiana. Maggie. Grace plays the part of Irina in the film, while Mackenzie Foy plays Renesmee, Edward and Bella, the middle-aged child. [51] The newborn Renesmee was interpreted by a robot. It was shot at the Canadian Motion Picture Park Studios (CMPP).
